

Guillaumet 2579msnm Chalten Patagonia Argentina.

A satellite peak of Fitz Roy, is one of the best objectives to try for first time in the area. There are different lines depending on the time of the year, weather conditions and the preferences of the climber.

The west face consist on golden granite rock worth touching. Comesana/ Fonrouge rout involves 400 meters up to 5.11 and a final snow field of 30 degrees to the summit,

On the other hand the east side present more snow and ice conditions. The Amy couloir is a classic one and the easiest way to climb this peak, 200 meters of 65 degrees. It joins the Fonrouge 150 meters below the summit.



Recommended month: October to march

Duration : 3 days

Pax: 1 or 2

Difficulty: moderate

Included: IFMG mountain guide, expedition meals, tent, elementos de cocina, technical gear, GPS, communication: VHF and satellite, equipo técnico individual (helmet, harness, crampons, carabiners , ice axes).

Not included : personal gear

Day 1: Approach to base camp Piedra Negra. From chalten take a shuttle to rio electric. From there we hike for two hours on an easy path to get to Piedra del Fraile fixe camp. After Piedra del Fraile we follow a steep path to get to piedra Negra where we set up our tent.

Elevation gain: 900 mts /5 hs

Day 2: Climbing . We leave Piedra negra early in the morning to attempt the peak. Before we start with the climb we will have to approach for two more hours, walking on unstable moraines and snow. After climbing we came back the same way to the tent left in Piedra Negra. /12 hs

Day 3: Piedra Negra /Chalten . we hike back the same way.
